They have recently been appointed as clinical tutors for the Teesside GIFT Implant course in association with the Warwick University, Implant MSc.

All implant supported prosthesis are provided by Richard Elliot, at Queensway's in-house laboratory.

Some of the latest 3D scanning and computer-aided manufacture processes are available in-house, and are used to construct cutting edge restorations.

We are happy to carry out all aspects of dental implant care along with

surgical support from visiting maxillo-facial surgeon Mr Rob Banks. Implant treatment options include socket preservation, guided bone regeneration, sinus augmentation and block grafting. It is also possible in certain cases to provide same day implants using Nobel Biocare's latest implant system (Nobel Active). Guided surgery is also possible with 3D scanning and Nobel guide software.

All implants and material are supplied by leading manufacturers such as Nobel Biocare, Biomet 3I and Geistlich.

The Result

“ I attended Queensway Dental Clinic to discuss the implant replacement of my failing upper front tooth. Following a thorough assessment with Mr Lane, I received a written treatment plan explaining the options for my implant care and the alternatives to replace my broken upper front tooth. Ian explained that the gum was thin in this area due to the infection and a small bone graft may be required to improve the gum width and implant support.

The surgery was carried out a couple of weeks later and there was no pain during the procedure. The area was uncomfortable for 3-4 days and the gum was a little bit swollen. A temporary crown was placed after a couple of months to allow the gum to heal in a natural way and the final all-ceramic crown was placed 7 months after the implant surgery. I also opted for some tooth whitening to brighten my smile and give a natural cosmetic improvement.”
