A dental implant is a titanium metal rod which is placed into the jawbone. It is used to replace a missing single tooth, several teeth, a full arch bridge, or even support a loose denture.

The benefits of dental implants are both functional and cosmetic. Unsightly gaps can be closed without adjacent teeth being affected and without the need for a denture. If you have several chewing teeth missing, dental implants will help reduce the pressure on your remaining teeth, improve your chewing ability and prolong the life of your natural teeth.

New implant technologies have been embraced at Queensway, allowing us to carry out advanced 3D scanning of jaws and use computer aided planning procedures. This minimises surgery time and reduces post-operative pain. Thanks to the development of same-day replacement treatment we can even offer immediate replacement of a failing tooth.

At Queensway Dental Clinic we have the training, expertise, facilities and team to replace missing teeth with dental implants. Our implant-qualified dentists will always provide you with an initial consultation to talk about what you want to achieve from dental implants. They will then be able to recommend suitable implant options and provide you with a bespoke treatment plan.

Queensway will always provide you with professional, honest and open consultations - aided by the use of digital photographs and x-rays. Working together we will help you to make informed decisions about your mouth, your teeth and your smile.

NHS and Private treatment

Whilst routine NHS patients at Queensway may be able to access some initial pre-implant stabilisation treatment such as an extraction or temporary dentures, most complex implant and reconstructive dental care is not possible on the NHS and must be paid for privately.

To make treatment more affordable, we offer 0% finance plans and low-costs loans. This can be discussed at your consultation.

Additionally, you may access a range of other advanced treatments that Queensway can offer, including specialist orthodontics to align teeth naturally, or specialist oral surgery services for advanced bone grafting. We can also provide facial aesthetics treatment with BOTOX® or fillers.

Our dental implant solutions include:

- Implant replacement for a single tooth, partial missing teeth or for complete tooth loss
- Mini implants to stabilise loose dentures
- Same day tooth replacement with an immediate implant and temporary crown
- Full or partial tooth replacement with 3D scanning and minimal surgery to reduce healing times and the need for stitches
- Advanced bone and sinus grafting by our visiting hospital consultant Maxillo-Facial surgeon
- Comprehensive follow-up appointments and maintenance care programmes with hygienist support
- In-house laboratory service to design your crowns, bridges and dentures

BDS, DGDGP(UK)RCS, Dip SED, MPhil, PhD, MSc Implant Dentistry

Paul qualified from Newcastle Dental School in 1990. Paul started his dental career in Durham, where he worked as a dental associate. In 1994, he established Queensway Dental Clinic and then went on to obtain his Diploma in General Dental Practice (DGDGP) and Diploma in Conscious Sedation in 1997.



Having held a special interest in dental implants for many years Paul's wide experience and training allow him to tailor care for his patients, including those who may require complex treatment, providing them with care which is both ethical and patient centred. Since 1993 Paul has been involved in the placement and restoration of implants. After training extensively for three years, Paul was awarded a Masters degree in Implant dentistry from Warwick University in 2008. Paul has attended numerous other national and international courses in pursuit of his continuing professional development in this field and he regularly participates in both regional and national study groups. Paul is an active member of the UK Association of Dental Implantology.

Dr Ian Lane

BDS (Hons), MFGDP, Dip SED, MSc Implant Dentistry

Ian qualified with an Honours degree from Newcastle University in 1998. In 2001, Ian was awarded the MFGDP qualification and this was followed by the Diploma in Conscious Sedation in 2002 from Newcastle University.



Ian has developed an interest in implant and reconstructive dentistry and has been very active in postgraduate education in this field. Ian has been a partner at Queensway since 2006 and has been involved in university research projects in implant care and conscious sedation. Ian has shown continued commitment to further education with his three year MSc implant programme at Warwick University, where he was awarded "best implant student in 2008."

Ian is keen to provide whole patient care where dentistry is delivered in a conservative and minimally invasive manner. In the last 2 years Ian has attended a one year restorative course with Paul Tipton in Manchester, a surgical implant course at Paris Medical School and a guided surgery residency with Paulo Malo in Lisbon, Portugal. He has also attended various scientific meetings in the UK and in Gothenburg, Sweden.

“I had been wearing dentures for about two years. The lower denture would work loose sometimes, despite the use of various adhesives etc. Paul Averley suggested I should have mini implants and within a week of placement of four mini implants I knew I had made the right decision. I now feel more confident when talking and look forward to meals out in restaurants.”

“After losing my teeth due to gum disease it was clear that I was unable to retain a lower denture so I made the decision to have a denture with 2 implants. The benefit from this type of denture is significantly better as I am confident when eating and I don't worry about dentures moving when talking. It's like having permanent teeth and it has changed my life positively.”

“I attended Queensway Dental Clinic to discuss the implant replacement of my failing upper front tooth. Following a thorough assessment with Mr Lane, I received a written treatment plan explaining the options for my implant care and the alternatives to replace my broken upper front tooth. Ian explained that the gum was thin in this area due to the infection and a small bone graft may be required to improve the gum width and implant support. The surgery was carried out a couple of weeks later and there was no pain during the procedure. The area was uncomfortable for 3-4 days and the gum was a little bit swollen. A temporary crown was placed after a couple of months to allow the gum to heal in a natural way and the final all-ceramic crown was placed 7 months after the implant surgery. I also opted for some tooth whitening to brighten my smile and give a natural cosmetic improvement.”
